GO in the Present Tense (Irregular Verb)

Statement (S + V)	Question (do /does + S + Inf.)	Negative (S + do /does + not +Inf.)	S + don't / doesn't + Inf.
			I don't go
	Do you go?		
he goes			
		she does not go	
we go			
			you don't go
		they do not go	

GO in the Past Tense

Statement (S + V)	Question (did+ S + Inf.)	Negative (S + did + not +Inf.)	S + didn't + Inf.
you went			
		he did not go	
			we didn't go
	Did they go?
